Privilege of the floor: Justine Fox informed the board that she and her husband are purchasing Matthews Bus Property located at 10 Forbes St. In a review of the presently 1974 deed for this property the Fox attorney found that there were restrictions in the deed dealing with the Town, that they would like removed.

- 1) to remove the 15 yr reference to the Town having first right to any sale of this property.
- 2) Have access to a strip of Town-owned property (approx 50' wide and 450' long) at the end of Forbes St, giving access to the Matthews property from a dedicated street. (From the time Matthews obtained the property from the Town they have been allowed to use the land to access their lot.)

Supervisor Mahus stated that he had Attorney Putney review the deed and the additional documents presented to the board by the Fox's. The first concern with the 15 yr clause in the deed would appear to have ended any first right provisions the Town had over the property. A motion by Councilperson Horr and a second by Councilperson Bacon to remove the 15 yr clause in the deed, as it has ended anyway. All in favor. MOTION CARRIED.

A motion by Councilperson Bacon and a second by Councilperson Horr to convey the Town owned parcel of land at the north end of Forbes to the Village of Dansville allowing the Village to extend Forbes St.to the Matthews Bus lot. The conveyance of this property to the Village will be complete upon the Village accepting the land and making the Matthews Property accessible to Forbes St. All in favor. MOTION CARRIED

Fox stated she would go the Village board and request them to accept the conveyance of this property and that they make the necessary improvements to extend Forbes St. to the Matthews property.
